On the basis of material used in the course the students are expected to acquire the following competences:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand the purpose and character of environmental law that are, inter alia, based on a coordination of levels of regulation, crosswise of national borders, sectors, resources and environmental issues • Understand the central role of UN and OECD at international level (involving also climate and energy law issues) • Understand environmental law as one of the most important EU regulatory issues • Understand the role of national government institutions in the shaping and administration of environmental law and policy (involving the reduced national sovereignty in the EU and the consequences of this in the national regulation and decision making) • Understand how the traditional command-and-control regulation is combined with market-oriented instruments (e.g. taxes, quota and standards) • Understand the importance of the law and order principles and other national traditions as part of the national environmental law
Kursusformål	<p>The aim of this course is to provide the students with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> . A profound knowledge of environmental law . An understanding of the vertical integration and harmonization of law at international, EU and

	<p>national levels</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> . An understanding of how the traditional legal principles are part of environmental law and supplemented by new international environmental principles in the Danish environmental regulation By the end of the course the students are expected to be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify, analyze and explain the regulatory approach used in the regulation of land-use, protection of nature, resource management etc. • Explain the connection between the regulatory approach and the environmental issues regulated by an act • Give a reasonable and well-founded assessment of connections between land- use regulation, pollution control, resource management and liability rules
<p>Indhold</p>	<p>During the course, the students will be introduced to the concept of sustainability and the environmental principles codified in conventions, the Treaty of Lisbon, EU-regulations and -directives as well as in the national legislation. Moreover, the students will be introduced to the different instruments used as part of the regulation. The importance of the constitutional protection of rights and values in the decision- making will also be described and discussed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The course will concentrate on the following main legal topics: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access to information, public participation, access to justice and other procedural instruments • Spatial planning as part of the implementation of international and EU obligations at the national level • Protection of biodiversity and the international protected nature (Natura 2000- areas) as part of the national nature law
